Student Absences

1. Students absent because of illness, family emergencies or the like, should be given sufficient time to make up the missed work. The school will arrange to send work home, if requested or deemed necessary.
2. Students absent because of attendance at school sponsored extra-curricular events (sports, music, science fair, speech contests, etc.) should be given sufficient time to make-up missed work. The classroom teacher may modify the missed workload if s/he deems it necessary.
3. Family trips and outings during the school term are considered absences not associated with our school and teachers are not responsible for any tutoring, homework, or make-up tests necessitated by such absences. Students and/or parents may request that work is sent home prior to the family outing. There is no guarantee that the work will be available. In addition, there is no way to re-create the experience that the student will miss. However, the key to success in these cases will depend on communication between home and school.
