Subject: 614-a-Home School Sport Participation Policy

Policy for Home-Schooled Student Participation in School Sports Teams

1. Students who are home-schooled may participate on a WCS sports team if:
 - a. there are not enough WCS students available to fill a teamthe home-schooled student is within the appropriate age range specified by the sport in question
 - b. Any home-schooled student who has been accepted as a member of a WCS sports team will be treated as a full member of the team, not as a substitute.
 - c. The student must meet the same eligibility, conduct and participation standards and qualifications of sports expected of all students participating in that activity. The student must participate in practices regularly.
 - d. Health and Liability form must be filled out and signed by a parent or guardian. (See attached form). This form will include a policy that states “any volunteer parent driver must meet eligibility of WCS insurance policy”
2. Home-schooled teams may be invited to practice with the WCS team, but will be responsible for their own admission fee into District Tournaments.

4. Any cost incurred will be divided equally among all participants (ie. gas, entrance of entire team into a tournament)
