Principal's Message

Greetings WCS,

So the heat is on! That is what the students are saying as they walk up and down the halls. Yes, summer-like weather has appeared with booming thunder, and with it the students are becoming a little more sluggish with more requests to do things outside.

It is really hard to imagine that this year has flown by so quickly. There is only two weeks left, and 3 main events for teachers and students to be concerned with: Fair Glen (Grades 5-8) or final class trips (Grades 1-4), Report Card Writing, and Graduation. Please make an effort to speak with your children to hang in there and make the most of every opportunity while at school.

For those of you who were able to attend the BBQ on Friday, I am sure you would agree the food was great, the amount of people who turned out was incredible, and the weather was splendid. Miss Loxton commented that the whole thing was just perfect; she could not have asked for a warmer reception.

In other news, the WCS School board made a large decision last week Thursday. They are turning the Joy School program into a **Junior Kindergarten Program** that will run two full days per week. The Curriculum for this program is en route to the school and should be here to review shortly. The program will run Mondays and Wednesdays,



September through June, with one set price per new family for the whole year (so spread the word). This means that a new teacher will need to be hired. We are looking for an Early Childhood Educator (ECE) to fill the role. If you know someone who might be interested, let us know and have them send us their cover letter, resume, statement of faith, and references. The deadline for all applicants is July 11th.

The Board continues to plan new ways to raise funds for the school during the 2008-2009; this may include dinner theatre, golf tournament, and/or New Members Drive. They are also training the new board members to carry on once the old board members step down in September.

At the moment, the board is contacting and making arrangements to visit a number of interested families whom I have had the privilege to sit with and inquire why they are interested in WCS. Once all these visits are completed, the board will be meeting again in early July to report how the visits went. It will also be a time to discuss the new possible executive positions of the board.

For the time being, continue to pray for the students, teachers, and families of WCS as this year closes and as plans begin to be formed for next year. Have a great and wonderful week!
