 - Cleaning room
 - Washing dishes, or other things
 - Yard work, etc.



Keeping Track:

Send in weekly or monthly reports of what you have done and how many hours you have earned. We will keep track of it school on our theme board. Spread the word – we are here to serve.

If every family were to earn 277 hours, the goal will be reached. That is just over 7 hours a week per family.
