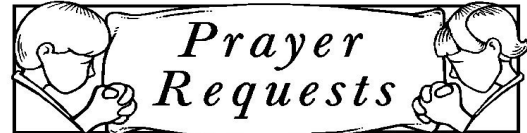
Open House & Registration Day
