1. They spoke to every teacher and asked them if there were any repairs that needed to be done in their classroom. They also did a walk around, both inside and outside, noting anything that they felt needed

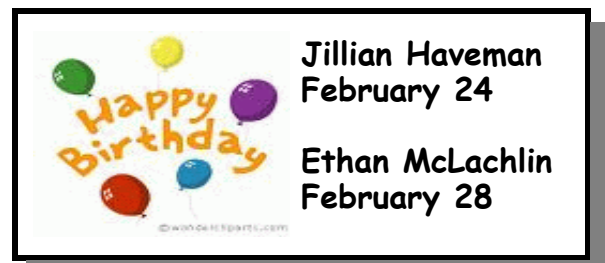
to be repaired. Once they had gathered the data, they wrote a report. I then sent that report to the school board.

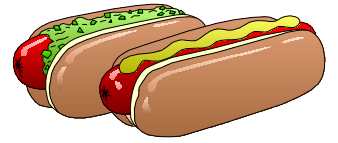
