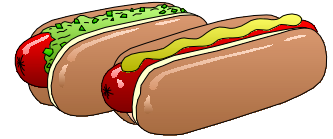
**French:** Independent French projects are due this **Thursday, March 25<sup>th</sup>**. Students will be presenting their readers and the creative component of the project on Thursday.
