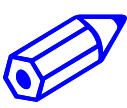

Greetings WCS,

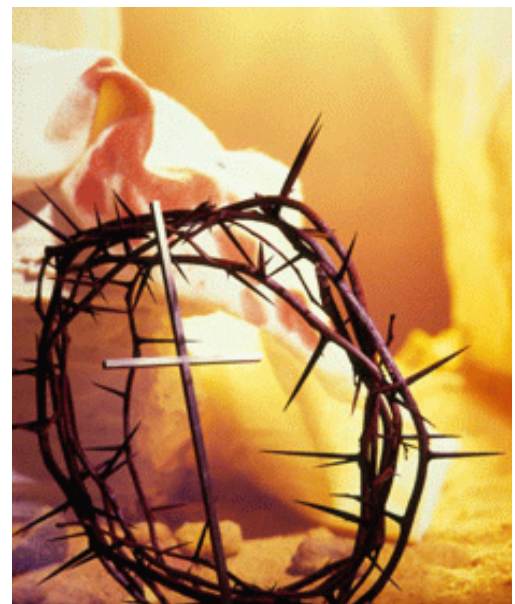

We made \$73.83 on Breakfast Day. Thanks to everyone who participated!

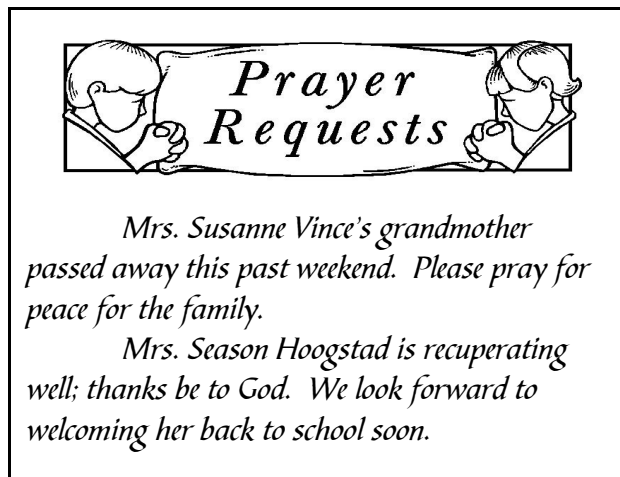
