PRINCIPAL PONDERINGS

On Thursday, our discipleship program took part in a fishing trip. 22 students traveled to Port Lambton to enjoy each other's company in God's creation. Dozens of fish were caught and lots of laughs were had. Students also learned that discipling and sharing God's word is similar to fishing. In both, you don't always get the results you want. Sometimes, when you share the gospel, you may not see the fruits of your labour, just like an unsuccessful fishing trip. However, that does not mean we give up. We press on and look for opportunities to speak about our faith with others and try not to get too discouraged. In a fishing context, a good fisherman wouldn't give up either. They'd simply try a new fishing hole to get better results. In both scenarios, you can't always see what is going on. When we share the gospel, God is often at work on the individual's heart, even when we don't always see the results manifest. Similarly, we can't always see the bait as it sinks deep into the water.

Our older students were helpful with their disciples. They were patient as they taught some of their buddies how to fish for the first time. They encouraged their disciples, especially those who took longer to catch their first fish. They also led by example and listened well to instructions. It was a blessing to see our students model Christ-like attitudes. We look forward to our next planned trip and to see what God will continue to do with our discipleship program.
